# Sedum rupestre 'Angelina'

Quick-spreading plant that has great foliage, offering year-round interest. Grows even in nutrient-poor, dry soil. Foliage is needle-like, resembling small conifer trees. Lime green spring leaves turn to bright yellow in summer, taking on coral tones of orange and red in cold months. Prefers full sun, but can tolerate bright shade with excellent drainage. Does not flower reliably, but, is planted for its stunning foliage. Best used as an accent on a roof, because it does not cover as densely as other groundcovers and may fade in unusually wet seasons. On edges of roofs and in planters it has a nice cascading effect. Excellent for adding unique color to any planting.

2-3 Plugs per sq. ft. – 12-18 Months coverage
