SEDUM SPURIUM 'ALBUM SUPERBUM' (AKA 'WHITE FORM')

Often referred to as “the white-flowering spurium”, *Sedum spurium* 'White Form' features a good spreading habit, beautiful green foliage, and clusters of star-shaped white flowers. Like all spuriums, it drops its scalloped leaves in the autumn, but sets rosettes at the tip of each stem that persist through the winter. Leaves on the plant are green year-round, becoming a dark bronze-green in the winter months. White flowers bloom Mid- to Late Summer and into the Autumn, providing great late season blossoms and interest. The variety 'White Form' shares the best features of the spuriums that make them a great plant on green roofs: exceptional drought tolerance, hardiness in heat and cold, dense foliage, and reliable flowers that attract butterflies, bees, and other pollinators. As an added bonus, this variety also tolerates a good amount of shade, although this may affect flowering and the plant may become more leggy. A great way to bring a white blossom onto a green roof or planted wall.
