Potentilla neumanniana syn. verna

This mat-forming groundcover offers distinctly textured foliage, adding interest to any green roof planting. The leaves of this plant typically stay green in milder winter climates. Sun yellow flowers bloom mid-spring and sporadically through the summer. A great performer, once established, and long lasting on a green roof; may require additional care and watering to become well established.
